3.4 Abstract Submission

Submission of an abstract is required for all presenters before the deadline. The deadline of the abstract submission is **8 October 2023**. Please send the abstract **via email <bainfo [at] bacoust.org>**. Template file for the abstract is available from Our web site.

All abstract including short oral presentation should be written in English. Please follow the instructions described in the WORD template. Figures cannot be included in an abstract.

The abstract must NOT exceed one page with less than 3,000 characters. The presenter has the responsibility to confirm the consent of all coauthors before checking the authorship box in the registration sheet.

Please include the following items in your abstract submission form.

- i. Presentation style
 - oral on-site
 - oral on-line (video presentation with on-line discussion)
- ii. Language
 - English Japanese
- iii. Presenter name(s). (Co-presenter should be included)
- iv. Presenter affiliation(s). (Co-presenter should be included)
- v. Abstract (< 3,000 characters; Figures cannot be included)
- vi. Copyright Transfer to the Society
 - I agree
- vii. Authorship
 - All the coauthors agreed to the paper presentation
- viii. Application for the Awards (see **Section 3.7**)

Acceptance of contributed papers will be notified by e-mail by **22 October 2022**. Some papers applied for oral presentation may be changed to short presentation.

The Conference Proceedings will be available to the members of the Society on our web site.

3.5 Joining the Meeting

Including on-site participants, registered presenters and attendee will receive URL to connect the meeting. Zoom will be used for the virtual meeting system. On-site registration will start at 12:00 on Saturday 4 November 2023 at University of Ryukyus.

3.6 Presentations

On-line presenters need to send the presentation video with voice ahead of the meeting according to the instruction from the organizing committee. This presentation video will be projected at the meeting, and on-line discussion will be held after then. On-site presenters have to send only the presentation slide ahead. Minor fixes are permitted at the venue. Video projection as on-line presenters is also available. Presentation materials should NOT use any materials protected by copyright unless otherwise permitted. On-line participants should mute during presentation, and click “Raise Hand Button” after presentation has finished when you have questions or comments.

3.7 Awards

Presentation awards are granted to excellent presentations. The award winners will be selected from presenters in English. You have to be a student member or a regular member who obtained a PhD degree within the last three years in order to apply for Awards. You have to indicate that you would like to apply for the Awards when you submit your abstract. The award ceremony will be held on 5 November 2023.
