3.4 Abstract Submission

Submission of an abstract is required for all presenters before the deadline. The deadline of the abstract submission is **20 October 2024.** Please send the abstract **via email <bar>bainfo** [at] **bacoust.org>**. Template file for the abstract is available from Our web site.

All abstract should be written in English. Please follow the instructions described in the WORD template. Figures can be included in an abstract. The abstract must NOT exceed one page with less than 3,000 characters. The presenter has the responsibility to confirm the consent of all coauthors before checking the authorship box in the registration sheet.

Acceptance of contributed papers will be notified by e-mail by 31 October 2022.

The Conference Proceedings will be available to the members of the Society on our web site.

3.5 Presentations

Presenters should bring their presentation files on the day of the presentation. Please prepare the files in Microsoft PowerPoint or PDF format. The organizing committee will provide the computers for presentations. Presenters will be notified of the presentation time as soon as it is decided.

3.6 Awards

Presentation awards are granted to excellent presentations. The award winners will be selected from presenters in English. You have to be a student member or a regular member who obtained a PhD degree within the last three years in order to apply for Awards. You have to indicate that you would like to apply for the Awards when you submit your abstract. The award ceremony will be held on 3 December 2024.
